Old Business:

- 1. Minutes for the 2012 meeting were approved by majority vote.
- 2. Treasurer's Report was submitted by Mike Gibson, read by Co-VP, Gary Deddo.

New Business:

- 1. The president's report (Chris):
 - -Our 2014 speaker in San Diego will be Myk Habets, of Carey Baptist College of New Zealand
 - -Donations of \$10 per year were encouraged so we might give honorariums to our speakers and assist with special events.
 - Douglas Farrow published an article in *First Things* re: TFT's views, especially as related to TFT's chapter "Karl Barth and the Latin Heresy" chapter 8 of his *Karl Barth: Biblical and Evangelical Theologian*. One or two of TFT TF members are responding to it by means of *FT*, Letters to the Editor.
- 2. Elections:
 - -President Chris Kettler announced his selection of current Co-vice president Gary Deddo, to serve as President for the term of 2014 through 2016.
 - Gary accepted Chris's appointment.
 - -Nomination of Myk Habets for Co-vice president (replacing Gary D.) was placed.
 - -Nomination of Paul Molnar to a second term as Member-at-Large
